

NARRATIVE

College of Education

Academic year 2000-2001 was an active one for the College of Education. Highlights of the year include the following:

1. *P-16 Activities:*

- a. Number of Partner Schools increased to 13.
- b. Over 500 field placements with Demonstration Teachers were made in Partner Schools.
- c. REVERSING THE ARROW: 21 College of Education faculty members invited 120 P-12 professionals to speak to their classes in the calendar year 1999.
- d. A framework for assessing the impact of Partner Schools on teacher preparation and P-12 student learning was adopted.

- *Graduate Studies:*
 - The College of Education awarded 12 Ed.D. degrees in 2000-2001.
- *Off-Campus Offerings (COASTAL AREA TEACHER EDUCATION SERVICES):*
- The College of Education offered 135 courses in 6 off-campus locations with a total of 1,136 students enrolled.
- *Curriculum Development:*
 - Teacher Education Program Standards (TEP) to meet new BOR regulations were completed and approved in all education programs.
- *Faculty Development:*
- Fifteen (15) stipends of \$500 each for DESIGNING COLLEAGUES (3), CROSSING BORDERS (5), MAKING CONNECTIONS (4) and CREATING PATHWAYS (3), efforts geared toward increasing collaboration among faculty and with K-12 practitioners, were granted to faculty members.
- *Field Experiences:*
- A total of 231 students successfully completed student teaching in the academic year 2000-2001.
- *Departmental Initiatives:*
- The Department of Middle Grades and Secondary Education received State of Georgia recognition for the emphasis on collaboration with P-12 schools by its Secondary Education Program.
- Student ratings of instruction averaged 4.5 (out of 5) for all courses during all semesters in the past year in the Department of Leadership, Technology, and Human Development.
- The Department of Curriculum, Foundations, and Research's web site provided updated instructions and listings for graduate internet courses. There have been over 23,690 hits on the home page during this past year.

- The Department of Early Childhood and Reading received a very positive review by the Professional Standards Commission. All programs were re-accredited with no weaknesses cited.
- *Post-Secondary Readiness Enrichment Program (PREP):*
- Twenty-nine (29) College of Education majors and 23 GSU students from other university colleges served as PREP tutors.
- Three county school systems received PREP services: Bulloch, Effingham, and Screven. Approximately 2,130 students in the region were served by the GSU PREP program.

Summary of Strengths, Weaknesses, and Needs

Strengths:

- College of Education faculty are productive scholars, significantly involved in service to local schools, and are serious about being good teachers.
- Redesign of curriculum to meet new Board of Regents Initiatives has been diligent and productive.
- Our partner school development plan reflects a noteworthy adherence to P-16 principles and practices.
- Collegial relationships with other colleges within Georgia Southern and our Teacher Education Advisory Council contribute greatly to the quality of our teacher education program.

- Our two doctoral programs (Educational Leadership and Curriculum Studies) are growing in numbers and reputation.
- All core courses for the M.Ed. degree are now offered on-line, a visible commitment to using technology to attract graduate students.
- Ninety-five percent of students successfully complete their student teaching experience.

Weaknesses:

- There is a need for more diversity among the faculty.
- The College of Education needs to make a more compelling case for student technology fee \$ to enhance our student labs.
- Grantsmanship in the college needs to be enhanced.
- The productivity of some of our graduate degree programs need to be studied and assessed.
- Fund-raising endeavors, especially related to the new College of Education building, are as yet undefined.

Needs:

- The University System of Georgia needs to be more supportive of plans to expand the Dublin Center.

Objectives for 2001-2002

COLLEGE OF EDUCATION

- College of Education responses to Program Review decisions will be diligently considered.
- A plan will be devised to eliminate a number of Ed.S. degrees and to create at least one interdisciplinary middle school/secondary education Ed.S. degree.
- A proposal for a new master's degree in Teaching and Learning (CFR) will be further defined.
- The College of Education will continue to study the implications of "Faculty Work in Schools Report" with the intent of devising ways to reward faculty for their involvement with P-12.
- The first middle school/secondary education cohort in Dublin will be initiated and sustained.

- Fund raising priorities and strategies for the College of Education will be determined.
