- Revised the Praxis II Requirement: A student must take the test prior to student teaching but passing the test is not a degree requirement.
- Approved a 1000-level course, EDUF 1230: Education, Society & Learners, which is open to the general student population.

- Initiation of the Teacher Internship Program - This program is designed to assist students from other careers in entering the teaching profession in a streamlined fashion. Twenty-seven students are currently enrolled in classes which will prepare them to begin employment in area school systems this fall. The TIP program is approved by the Georgia Teacher Alternative Preparation Program (GTAPP) and is offered in conjunction with First District RESA. This collaboration allows us to serve school systems throughout the First Congressional District.

4. P-16 Activities

- Number of Partner Schools increased to 14 schools with 21 faculty involved in reform initiatives.
- Began planning for the first Professional Development District in the United States.
- All 14 partner schools completed voluntary NCATE PDS Standards self-studies. The self-studies were reviewed by a panel of COE and public school faculty. The results of the studies will be used to further planning and development efforts as well help disburse funds more efficiently.
- Demonstration Teacher selection and retention policy was altered. All Demonstration Teachers will be TSS certified by 2004. TSS training is being provided by the COE faculty at no expense to the teachers.
- REVERSING THE ARROW: 77 P-12 professional participated as speakers in classes at the University. Eight participated on Special Education Portfolio Review Panel.
- Developed collaborative Beginning Teacher Induction Model.
- Developed Program to Assure Quality Model (PAQ) for guarantee of graduates.
- Received Standards-based Teacher Education Program Grant of \$8,000 which funded institutional analysis of Math Education and English Education Programs.
- Support for collaborative presentations at state and national conferences.
- Supported 269 master Demonstration Teachers involved in teacher preparation.
- Twenty-one Field Associates served as University liaisons to Partner Schools.

 - Updated departmental website and developed a new web page for the Center for International Schooling that is housed within the department.

 - All Special Education faculty were accepted to present papers at national and international conferences.
 - Two Special Education faculty served on boards of national professional organizations.
 - Four Special Education faculty served as field associates in P-16 partnerships with Portal Elementary School and Brooklet Elementary School.
 - Special Education faculty recruited 9 students for Ed.S. cohort, redesigning courses for delivery in on-line and weekend college formats.
- Middle Grades and Secondary Education
 - Two new M.Ed. & Ed.S. Middle Grades and Secondary programs beginning Fall of 2002 were developed for Effingham County and Dublin.
 - For the first time, all Department of Middle Grades and Secondary Education were accepted to make presentations at national conferences.
 - Departmental faculty in middle grades began to review and convert the B.S.Ed. in Middle Grades to a performance-based program to address

the new NCATE standards, new technology standards, and the NBPTS standards.

- Departmental faculty in middle grades and secondary education developed a draft of a new M.Ed. in Middle Grades and new M.Ed. program in Secondary.
- The Education Advisement Center recently acquired the PLATO Learning System, an internet-based computer tutorial system designed to assist students in their preparation for the Praxis I exam. This system will replace Learning Plus and will eliminate the requirement that students use it at an on-campus location. Center personnel worked closely with PLATO representatives and were instrumental in bringing the program to university system schools at an affordable group rate.

9. Post-Secondary Readiness Enrichment Program (PREP)

- A total of 38 Georgia Southern University students served as PREP Team tutors during FY '01. Twenty of the 38 students are College of Education majors and 18 are majors in other colleges: COBA (5), CHPS (4), CLASS (5), and CST (4).
- During the year-round program, three county school districts were targeted for services. Middle grades students visiting the university campus and students attending the summer camp program hosted by PREP represented an additional five counties.
