

NARRATIVE

College of Education

Academic year 1999-2000 was an active one for the College of Education. Highlights of the year include the following:

1. *P-16 Activities:*

a. 10 schools submitted Partner School proposals.

b. 43 teacher mini-grants of \$100 each, 14 school grants of \$500 each, and awards totaling \$10,000 to the 10 schools submitting a Partner School proposal were made.

c. REVERSING THE ARROW: 32 College of Education faculty members invited 175 P-12 professionals to speak to their classes in the calendar year 1999.

d. A Partner School retreat was held in October, 1999 at Hilton Head. A total of 20 schools participated with 4 representatives each plus 15 College of Education faculty and staff. Lee Teitel of the University of Massachusetts served as the program facilitator.

- *Graduate Studies:*
 - The College of Education awarded 14 Ed.D. degrees in 1999.
- *Off-Campus Offerings (COASTAL AREA TEACHER EDUCATION SERVICES):*
- The College of Education offered 141 courses in 15 off-campus locations with a total of 1,324 students enrolled.
- *Advising Center:*
- Total number of student advised was 1,609 in the B.S.Ed. and non-degree initial certification programs. In addition, 250 non-degree certification transcript evaluations were completed, 75 HOPE Teacher and Promise Scholarships were processed as were 125 HOPE Teacher Promise Renewals.
- *Curriculum Development:*
 - Teacher Education Program Standards (TEP) to meet new BOR regulations were completed and approved in all education programs.
- *Faculty Development:*
- Twenty-nine (29) stipends of \$500 each for DESIGNING COLLEAGUES, CROSSING BORDERS, and MAKING CONNECTIONS, efforts geared toward increasing collaboration among faculty and with K-12 practitioners, were granted to faculty members.
- *Field Experiences:*
- A total of 383 students completed student teaching in the calendar year 1999.
- *Departmental Initiatives:*

- The Department of Middle Grades and Secondary Education has developed and refined a new faculty mentoring program providing a direct link to the annual faculty evaluation process.
- The Department of Leadership, Technology, and Human Development made extensive revisions in the M.Ed., Ed.S., and Ed.D. programs that specifically address Board of Regents Principles.
- The Department of Curriculum, Foundations, and Research provided an updated internet course interface for graduate students in core courses being offered entirely on-line, plus information and links to the newest on-line courses.
- The Department of Early Childhood and Reading revised the undergraduate program of study by incorporating required concentrations in mathematics and reading as well as technology and field-based experiences.
- *Post-Secondary Readiness Enrichment Program (PREP):*
- Forty-nine (49) College of Education majors served as PREP tutors and counselors in 1999.

Summary of Strengths, Weaknesses, and Needs

Strengths:

- College of Education faculty are productive scholars, significantly involved in service to local schools, and are serious about being good teachers.
- Redesign of curriculum to meet new Board of Regents Initiatives has been diligent and productive.
- Our partner school development plan reflects a noteworthy adherence to P-16 principles and practices.

- Collegial relationships with other colleges within Georgia Southern and our Teacher Education Advisory Council contribute greatly to the quality of our teacher education program.
- Our two doctoral programs (Educational Leadership and Curriculum Studies) are growing in numbers and reputation.
- All core courses for the M.Ed. degree are now offered on-line, a visible commitment to using technology to attract graduate students.
- Ninety-five percent of students successfully complete their student teaching experience.

Weaknesses:

- There is a need for more diversity among the faculty.
- The College of Education needs to make a more compelling case for student technology fee \$ to enhance our student labs.
- Grantsmanship in the college needs to be enhanced.
- The productivity of some of our graduate degree programs need to be studied and assessed.

- Fund-raising endeavors, especially related to the new College of Education building, are as yet undefined.

Needs:

- The University System of Georgia needs to be more supportive of plans to expand the Dublin Center.

Objectives for 2000-01

- College of Education will plan for a successful Spring 2001 NCATE/PSC visit.
- Each department will successfully complete a Program Review, an aspect of the GSU Strategic Plan.
- A new Faculty Development Award will be offered to enhance collaboration with colleagues from other universities and international colleagues.

- The cohort for Early Childhood majors at the Dublin Center will be initiated; plans for the Middle Grades/Secondary Education cohort that starts Fall, 2001, will be completed.
- A new College of Education Governance Structure will be recommended and reviewed.
- "Faculty Work in Schools" Report will be studied by the College of Education faculty and a task force will study ways to successfully turn work in schools into verifiable scholarship.
- At least 10 Partner Schools will be created and active.
- A smooth transition for students and faculty to the new College of Education building will occur; dedication ceremony representing a wide constituency will be planned.
